The College of Liberal Arts and Sciences requires a minimum of 15 credits of separation between major combinations. In other words, for academic fields that have substantial overlap, **students must complete 15 credits unique to each of the majors** to become eligible to apply for a double major or dual degree. The exclusive credits apply to core major requirements and not to the rest of the degree (college, state, etc.).

The majors in *this category* have very much in common. To become eligible to apply for any of these combinations of programs, you must have **already completed** the 15 credits exclusive to each major. As proof of the separation, you must fill out this worksheet and attach it to your double major/dual degree application. Applications must be submitted prior to your anticipated final semester.
